# MCI team visits Gotri medical college again

Vadodara: After failing to clear the criteria required for starting a new medical college and hospital at Gotri the first time, its authorities are expecting to get the green signal after the second round of inspection that began on Monday. A three-member inspection team has been sent by Medical Council of India (MCI) to take an overview of the facilities at the college and hospital once again.

The team, which arrived at Gotri for a two-day visit, comprises of three members from Delhi and Hyderabad. They visited all the departments, classrooms, operation theatres and laboratories. "The initial feedback has been good and the team is satisfied with the facilities and infrastructure. This time we are hopeful that necessary permission will be given," superintendent of Gotri hospital Dr Rajiv Deveshwar said.

Deveshwar also said things are picking up and stream of patients walking in the hospital is also increasing. "The inspection was on till late evening and will continue on Tuesday. The team is verifying the records and data as well as checking the facilities at the premises. They also seem to be happy with the staff as they have made no comments yet on scarcity of the staffers on campus," Deveshwar said.
